

LOVE IS ALL WE NEED!

Spin Art Flower Bouquet

- Spin art machine
- Pack of white circles
- Glitter paints
- Flower template
- Pencil
- Scissors
- Glue stick
- White poster board piece
- Black permanent marker
- Piece of parchment paper
- Paint brush
- Glue dots or white glue
- Paper towels

**This project is easiest to follow through instructional video.

1. Set up your spin art machine by making sure the white mechanism is in place in the red part.
2. The white paper circles fit into the white mechanism and secure in.
3. Open paints and squeeze small amounts of paint onto white circles.
4. Pull the white lever on the side of the red part of the machine. (See video)
5. Add more colors and repeat.
6. Remove circle and repeat with the next white circle and so on.
7. Let the circles dry.
8. Once dry, trace flower onto circles using flower template and pencil.
9. Cut flowers out with scissors.
10. Overlap one petal onto one next to it and use a glue stick to make them stay put.
11. Your flowers should have 5 petals now. (See video)
12. Draw a vase or pot onto your parchment paper using your black marker.
13. You can also draw designs on it if you would like.
14. Cut your vase out with scissors.
15. Using glue dots attach flowers to the top of your poster board.
16. Draw stems for flowers on poster board using black marker.
17. Your parchment vase/pot is going to be attached to the bottom of the poster board where the stems are.
18. Before you do that, you can use your paint brush and blue paint to paint "water" on your poster.
19. Use your glue stick to attach vase to poster board.
20. Add whatever else you would like to your picture and enjoy!

Faux Stained Glass Picture

- Thin plastic sheet
- White matte frame
- Black permanent marker
- Glitter paint
- White glue
- Paint palette
- Paint brush
- Cup of water
- Paper towels
- Sheet in DabbleBox with "LOVE" design and exploding heart
- Scotch tape

**This project is easiest to follow through instructional video.

1. Decide which design from the sheet of paper you want to trace.
2. On your plastic sheet, trace your design using black permanent marker.
3. On your paint palette, squeeze a dollop of each color of glitter paint.
4. Add a squirt of white glue to each paint color and mix.
5. Flip over your plastic sheet...you will be painting on the opposite side as the marker.
6. Now using your glue-paint mixtures, paint your picture.
7. Do not forget to clean and dry brush between colors.
8. Let dry.
9. On your white matte frame, draw a design with your black permanent marker.
10. Once paints dry, attach with scotch tape to your frame.
11. Hang in a sunlit window and enjoy your stained glass!

Love-Themed Agamograph

- Blank piece of paper with 7 parallel straight lines on it
- Other paper with lines and flower picture and "Love Always Wins" picture
- Paint brush
- Glitter Paint
- Scissors
- Glue stick

**This project is easiest to follow through instructional video.

1. Paint your two pictures however you like.
 2. Let paint dry.
 3. Cut pictures on the straight lines so that you have 8 strips/sections.
 4. Keep them in order...you should have 4 strips from the flower picture, and 4 strips from the other picture.
 5. Fan fold the other piece of paper, using the straight parallel lines as your guide.
 6. Use your glue stick to attach flower picture strips to every other section on the fan folder paper. (See video)
 7. Now glue the "Love Always Wins" strips into the other every other sections.
- **Remember, these pieces should still be in order!
8. This is kind of like a puzzle.
 9. Re-crease your fan folds again and stand paper up on table.
 10. Your picture will now look different from different angles.
 11. If you look at it from one angle, you should see the full flower bouquet.
 12. If you look at it from another angle, you should see "Love Always Wins".

"Home is Where the Heart is" Photo Holder

- Rectangular wood base
- Wooden house
- Moss sheet
- Silver heart stand
- Scissors
- Cork doormat
- Heart sticker
- Plastic gems and other embellishments
- Black permanent marker
- White glue
- Glitter paint
- Paint palette
- Paint brush
- Cup of water
- Paper towels

**This project is easiest to follow through instructional video.

1. Paint and decorate your wooden house and let dry.
2. Draw a design with black marker (and paint if you like) onto cork doormat.
3. Stick your heart stand and house onto your wooden base.
4. Cut up your moss sheet and use white glue to stick onto wood base around the house and heart stand.
5. Stick doormat on top of moss and in front of your house.
6. Use stickers, gems and other embellishments to decorate the moss and house.
7. Find a family photo and put in the heart photo holder.
8. "Home is where the heart is!"
